If you need another copy of the registration form, genealogy form, or the accommodations list from the last newsletter, they are all available for print-out or download from the Standing Family website under "Planning 2006."

The website has been reorganized a bit. Pages now include a 'navigation bar' to help the user jump between sections.

We have started a section of 'family archives' on which we hope to build. To date, items include a section of a few photos devoted to the "Bear Creek" environs, to our earliest relatives, and to George and Deborah; the "Brief History" of the family is posted; a chart of early ancestors; and links to additional documents found on the Nicholson/Standing Artists site (which also has more material). Also included is the 1985 version of "Descendants of George and Deborah Standing." This is the most recent edition Ted Foster had on hand, but he hopes to update this. Contributions of additional materials and suggestions are welcome. One item Ted would like is a photo of the old school house that was recently torn down.

There are also some biographical documents, genealogy, and links to family member sites.
